	<p><b>Finding Your OS Version</b></p> <p>Now that you have a brief introduction to the handful of versions, let's figure out what you have running.</p> <p>Starting from your home screen, press <b>Menu &gt; Settings</b> (or find settings in your app drawer/dock) <b>&gt; About Phone</b> (scroll all the way down, it's the last option).</p> 



Once you have reached the **About Phone** page you will be greeted with several menu items including the status of your phone and likely the battery use. This “about” page breaks down the model number, Android version, mod version, and build of your phone. It provides some very handy information when it comes to knowing about your phone. It should look something like this:
